


**ORDER: SPREAD ON THE MINUTES THE ACCEPTANCE OF MS


The vote on the motion was as follows:







**Scope of Work**

Lafayette County has been allocated \$20,000.00 for the purchase of MSWIN capable radios. Competitive bids will be sought in order to maximize the purchasing power of these funds.

The grant allocation will be divided equally between the Lafayette County Sheriff's Office and the Lafayette County Fire Department. Both agencies are in need of MSWIN radios for more reliable local communications as well as interoperable communications with State, Federal and other local jurisdictions. This equipment is intended to enhance the capability of our local agencies to prevent, respond to, and mitigate incidents of terrorism involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive weapons and cyber attacks.
