RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE LAFAYETTE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL PARK TO MCGREGOR INDUSTRIAL STEEL FABRICATION, INC. PURSUANT TO MISS. CODE ANN. §57-7-1.

WHEREAS, Lafayette County, Mississippi, hereinafter referred to as the "Seller" is the fee simple title holder of the hereinafter described real property (Exhibit "A" hereto) located in the Lafayette County Industrial Park, Lafayette County, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, McGregor Industrial Steel Fabrication, Inc., hereinafter referred to as McGregor, has expressed an interest and desire in acquiring a ten acre tract of said real property located between the parcels occupied by SWM, Inc. and Caterpillar, Inc. for the purpose of constructing, developing and operating, inter alia, an industrial warehouse facility for the benefit of Caterpillar, Inc.; and

- Section 1. The Governing Body of the County does hereby approve the sale of the subject property for the amount of \$100,000 to McGregor Industrial Steel Fabrication, Inc.
- Section 2. That the subject property is no longer needed for County or related purposes and is not to be used in the operation of the County, that the sale of the subject property in the manner otherwise provided by law is not necessary or desirable for the financial welfare of the County, and that the use of the County property for the purpose for which it is to be sold will promote and foster the development and improvement of the Lafayette County community and the industrial and economic welfare thereof.
- Section 3. That the sale of the subject property, as described in the attached Exhibit "A" hereto is hereby approved under the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract for Sale which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B."

Section 4. The President and Clerk of the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Contract for Sale of the subject property, Warranty Deed, as well as any and all other documents necessary to effectuate the sale of the subject property.
