


**ORDER: DECLARE AS SALVAGE AND DELETE INGERSOLL


The vote on the motion was as follows:

Supervisor Mike Roberts, voted yes

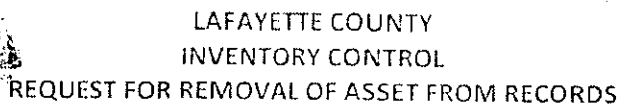
After the vote, President Busby, declared the motion carried, this the 15th day of December, 2014.
