Dear Friends:

It has come to my attention that some circuit and chancery clerks may not be aware of a provision of our law that allows indigent citizens to file a civil action without being required to pay a filing fee, upon the filing of the appropriate oath.

Section 11-53-17 of the Mississippi Code provides that [a] citizen may commence any civil action, or answer a rule for security for costs in any court without being required to prepay fees or give security for costs, before or after commencing suit, by taking and subscribing to [an appropriate oath].

I would be grateful if you would make sure the clerks and deputy clerks are aware of this statute. All citizens are entitled to access to our courts.
