


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT

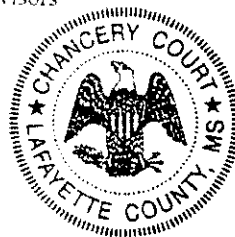
