




ORDER APPOINTING JURY COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS the regular 1974 session of the Legislature of the State of Mississippi, provided by Chapter 378 of the General Laws of the 1974 Session, that a Jury Selection Commission be appointed in each county of the State of Mississippi and,

WHEREAS, the provision of Section 3 of said Act and particularly Section 13-5-6 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 session require the appointments be made, one by the Circuit Court Judge, one by the Chancery Court Judge and one by the Board of Supervisors of each county in the particular district of each judge or senior judge.

NOW THEREFORE be and it is hereby ordered by the Board of Supervisors of Lafayette County, Mississippi, that Linda Sallis, who is duly qualified as an elector and resident citizen in said county, and not an attorney nor an elected public official, thus meeting the qualifications of the law, be and is hereby appointed as Jury Commissioner of said county for a term of four (4) years, beginning and being effective the 1st day of January, 2016, and she shall on or before said date, or before performing any official duties as Jury Commissioner, take the general oath of office required of public officials and file same with the Chancery Clerk of the County.

SO ORDERED this the 4th of January, 2016, and placed upon the minutes of the Court by the Clerk of the Court on Jan. 21, 2016.
