


**ORDER: APROVE CHESTER STARKS TO ATTEND COUNTY SERVICE OFFICER

REFERENCE: Information on May 2016 CVSO training

The Mississippi Code 35-3-21 **requires** the County Veteran Service Officers in Mississippi to attend at least one of the schools of training provided by the MS State Veteran Affairs Board. Each person who attends the training is required to complete a registration form (attached) and to sign in each day to verify attendance.

The attached registration form is required for someone to attend the training. Return the completed form to SVAB Claims Division, P.O. Box 55949, Jackson, MS 39296 no later than April 27, 2016. The training will be conducted from 12:00 noon on Wednesday, May 11, 2016 and conclude at noon on Friday, May 13, 2016.

THERE IS NO REGISTRATION FEE.

American Legion Post 69 has graciously agreed to allow us the use of their facility for this training session. It is located at 308 Chubby Dr. in Columbus, MS.

This year we have two options for hotel reservations for those who need overnight accommodations:

The reservation cutoff date is April 11, 2016.
