ARTICLE V: MINIMUM REQUIRED SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS

Section 6: Storm Water Drainage, Add Paragraph I

Also in -

ARTICLE II: APPROVAL PROCESS FOR CONDOMINIUMS, APARTMENTS AND COMMERCIAL COMPLEXES

Section 2: Paragraph F, Sub-paragraph 3, change last sentence to read as follows:

"The development shall comply with the design standards in Article V, Section 6, Paragraphs E, G, H and I and Article V, Section 8, Paragraphs A and B."

Also in -

ARTICLE IIIA: APPROVAL PROCESS FOR MANUFACTURED HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS

Section 1: Paragraph J, 1. Add the words "and ARTICLE V" to the end of the sentence.

&

ARTICLE IIIB: RECREATIONAL VEHICLE DEVELOPMENTS

Section 4: Paragraph (a), add the words "and ARTICLE V" to the end of the third sentence.

(WORDING)

INSPECTION & ACCEPTANCE: Storm sewer lines shall be thoroughly cleaned and checked for obstructions along each line and from inlet/junction box to inlet/junction box. All sand, silt and debris shall be removed from the line. Each line shall then be checked by mirrors and sunlight or by a light flashed for grade. Each line shall then be video inspected as part of the testing. The developer will furnish the County two copies of the video on CD. Twenty-four (24) hours notice shall be given to the County Engineer prior to beginning the video inspection so that a representative from the County can be on site if possible. The developer shall conduct the video testing at his expense and shall repair any horizontal and/or vertical displacement, or any other defects observed.

2. CHANGE ARTICLE IV: DESIGN STANDARDS FOR SUBDIVISIONS, SECTION 1, PARAGRAPH A TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Unless specified elsewhere in this standard, the minimum setback for any county road is thirty (30) feet from the edge of the right-of-way or sixty (60) feet from the centerline whichever is greater, regardless of whether the road is shown on a platted subdivision."
