




Motion was made by Chad McLarty, duly seconded by Mike Roberts,

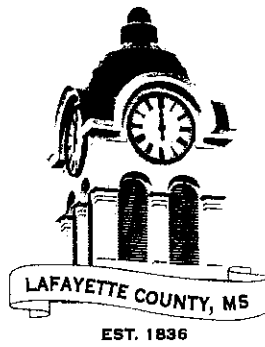

Dear Mr. Waller:

In accordance with your E-mail to Larry Britt of September 30<sup>th</sup> regarding conditions related to the Waller family's grant of a temporary construction easement and temporary access easement to Lafayette County, please be advised that the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors agrees to the following conditions:

1. All trees and debris are to be removed from the construction site and disposed of off-site by the contractor.
2. The access road to the site will be restored, as may be required, to preconstruction conditions, including, but not limited to filling of ruts, grassing, etc.
3. The gate on the access road between the NEMEPa property and the Waller property will remain locked when the Contractor is not working. This condition may require that a "double lock" be installed on the gate and the Waller family will initially open their lock to allow installation of the double lock. The double lock will be removed upon completion of construction.

4. Certain changes regarding stockpiling of rip-rap and a 25 foot transition area will be made to the plans and contract documents.
5. Items 1-3 above will be incorporated into the plans and contract documents to insure compliance by the contractor.

Upon receipt of this letter, it is our understanding that the Waller family will execute the temporary easements to Lafayette County.

Your cooperation in this matter is certainly appreciated.
