As you may recall from our previous meeting, Oxford Springs is more than 2,600 acres. We have received approvals from Federal and State agencies for our roads and lakes. These approvals provide a framework from which to develop a comprehensive Land Use Map. The attached Land Use Map is diagram which identifies numerous uses and outlines their contribution to the entirety of the Oxford Springs development.
