


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE APPROVAL OF BOARD ORDER ON STATE AID

Motion was made by Mike Roberts, duly seconded by Chad McLarty, to approve Board Order on State Aid Special Complex Bridge Inspections


The vote on the motion was as follows:

**ORDER OF BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
LAFAYETTE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Lafayette County has been advised by the State Aid Engineer of the Office of State Aid Road Construction that certain bridges within the county will require an inspection as set forth under the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS) and the AASHTO Manual for Bridge Evaluation (MBE), Inspection of Fracture Critical Bridge Members (Report No. FHWA-IP-86-26), Bridge Inspector's Reference Manual (Publication No. FHWA NHI 12-049, December 2012), AASHTO's Manual for Bridge Element Inspection, 1st Edition, with 2015 Interim Revisions and State Aid's National Bridge Inspection Program Local System Manual (BIM); and,

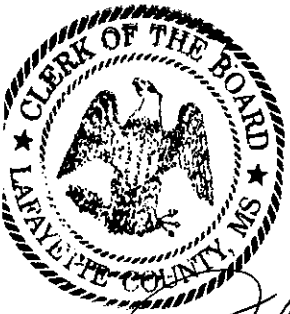
WHEREAS, Federal regulations require that such professional inspection services be solicited and selected in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Federal-Aid Policy Guide and 23 CFR 172, and


WHEREAS, the Office of State Aid Road Construction proposes to act as the lead agency for soliciting and selecting a consultant to perform this service statewide.

NOW THEREFORE, this Board does hereby order as follows:


1. The State Aid Engineer is hereby authorized to act for and on behalf of the Board in the process of selecting a consultant capable of performing the required inspections. The consultant selection will be in accordance with 23 CFR 172; and
2. The State Aid Engineer and his representatives are hereby authorized to act for and on behalf of the Board in all matters related to the administration of the aforementioned inspection project; and
3. The consultant selected for the inspections on behalf of the Board is hereby authorized to conduct the inspections of any and all county bridges as may be required under the above referenced federal standards; and
4. The consultant will upload inspection data, findings and other documentation into the State Aid **InspectTech** bridge software system and provide reports based on their findings and in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards (23 CFR 650.3); and

The consultant will be compensated with Federal BR monies and matching Federal Bridge Credit.
