CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF INVOLUTARY CIVIL COMMITMENT **EXAMINATION SERVICES**

Code Ann.§ 41-21- 61 et seq., hereby enters into this agreement with Dr. Milton Hobbs, M.D., as follows:

- 1. Dr. Milton Hobbs, M.D., a licensed physician who maintains a medical practice in Oxford, Mississippi, agrees to be available for appointment by the Chancery Court to perform preliminary mental and physical examinations as required by Miss. Code Ann. 41-21-67, for the purpose aiding in the Chancery Court's determination of whether respondents are in immediate need of mental treatment within the meaning of Miss. Code Ann. 41-21-67; and
- 2. Dr. Milton Hobbs agrees to accept a per examination fee in the amount of \$300. inclusive of all costs.
- 3. Upon receipt of a duly entered court order reflecting Dr. Hobbs' appointment as an examining physician and establishing and approving the examination fee of \$300, the County agrees to pay said fee out of the general funds of the County.
