


**ORDER: ACCEPT AND BEGIN EQUALIZATION OF PERSONAL AND REAL

SUGGESTED ORDER OF BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
OPENING SESSION FOR EQUALIZATION OF ASSESSMENTS  
OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

JULY TERM - 2017

IN THE MATTER OF REAL AND PERSONAL ASSESSMENT ROLLS OF  
COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

This day came on to be considered by the Board of Supervisors of Lafayette County, Mississippi, the matter of equalizing assessments of real and personal property for the year 20 17 and the Board affirmatively finds and adjudicates that Sylvia Baker, Tax Assessor of Lafayette County, has completed and filed the 20 17 real and personal assessment rolls of Lafayette County, Mississippi, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 27-35-81, Miss. Code Ann., has delivered the said rolls in legal form to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of this county on or before the First Monday of July, 20 17, and that the said Assessor has made and appended to said real and personal property rolls the affidavit in the form and as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that this Board of Supervisors will immediately at its 413, 20 17 meeting proceed to equalize such rolls and will cause to be assessed any person, or thing, found to be omitted, and correctly value any property found to be undervalued, and do all things required by Section 27-35-87, Miss. Code Ann., and other laws, and cause all corrections to be made in the said rolls, and will complete such equalization at least ten (10) days before the August, 20 17 meeting, and upon adjournment will immediately by newspaper publication notify the public that such rolls so equalized are ready and open for inspection and examination.

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED this 3rd day of July, 20 17.

NOTE: If rolls are filed later than the First Monday in July, change, "July" to "August" with appropriate dates, and make reference to filing in accordance with extension granted.

You are hereby notified that the real and personal property assessment rolls of Lafayette County, for the year 2017 have been equalized according to law, and that said rolls are ready for inspection and examination, and that any objections to said rolls or any assessment therein contained, shall be made in writing and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Lafayette County on or before the 7th day of August, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at her office in the Chancery Building of Lafayette County, and that all assessments to which no objection is then and there made, will be finally approved by said Board of Supervisors, and that all assessments to which objection is made, and which may be corrected and properly determined by this Board, will be made final by this Board of Supervisors, and that said rolls and the assessments contained therein will be approved by this Board of Supervisors, and that:

1. This Board will be in session, for the purpose of hearing objections to the said assessments which may be filed at the Chancery Building in the City of Oxford, Lafayette County, Mississippi, on the 7th day of August, 2017.
2. This Board of Supervisors will remain in session from day to day until all objections, lawfully filed, shall have been disposed of and all proper corrections made in the said rolls.
