


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE A NO COST EXTENSION OF THE MSU TITLE III


The vote on the motion was as follows:

Sadly we did not spend all of the funds by December 31, 2017 and we are not likely to do so. Therefore I am requesting one final No Cost Extension of the Agreement. Please feel free to call me and discuss after you read through the emails on the previous requests etc. The main point is that it will not cost Lafayette County anything and it will allow our account to remain open. We have been funding scholarships for our Youth Conservation Camps at Tara Wildlife and that is what I plan to do with the remaining funds of about \$2,000 m/l.
