


**ORDER: SPREAD ON THE MINUTES THE 2017 RECAPITULATION OF

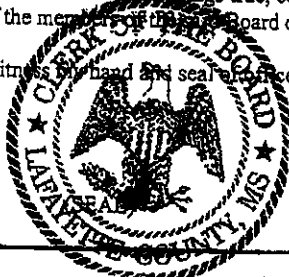

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE

It appears to the satisfaction of the Department of Revenue of the State of Mississippi, after visiting the said county of this State, conferring with the Assessor thereof and studying the values of the various classes of properties therein, the economic conditions thereof and the methods employed by the Assessor and Supervisors in making and equalizing the assessments, thereof, and after making a careful examination of the recapitulation of the assessment rolls of Real and Personal Property of Lafayette County for the tax year 20 17 as shown by the foregoing statements (appearing on the reverse side hereof) that they are reasonably equal and uniform with the assessments of the other counties of the state, as approved or as changed by the orders of the Department of Revenue.
