Now came time to discuss citizen's concern about speed bumps and stop signs in Harmontown. No action was taken.

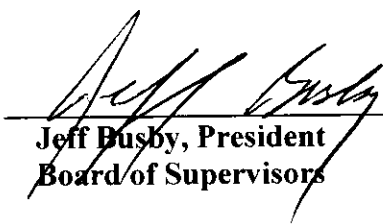

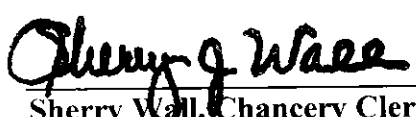
