A public hearing was held at this time for Central Grading District Annexation. No one came forward and spoke on the annexation or objected. No action was taken.


**ORDER: APPROVE RELEASE OF LETTER OF CREDIT FOR RHETT'S PLACE IN

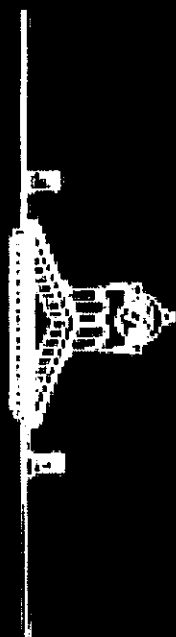
The vote on the motion was as follows:
