


**ORDER: ADOPT RESOLUTION REGARDING FUNDING FOR THE

## **LAFAYETTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S** **RESOLUTION**

At a bi-monthly meeting of the Lafayette County Board of Supervisor's held on January 15, 2017, the following resolution was adopted:

**WHEREAS**, the Lafayette County Board of Supervisor's desires to submit a plea to maintain the historical percentage to the local jurisdiction of sixty percent of the funds derived from the Emergency Management Performance Grant Program Administered through the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Lafayette County Emergency Management Agency is vitally reliant upon our partner, the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency for Support, Funding, and as a Liaison to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, furthermore, The Lafayette County Board of Supervisor's fully supports the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency in their efforts to promulgate the continued support of the local Emergency Management Agencies in all eighty two Counties and the Choctaw Nation of Mississippi; and,

**WHEREAS**, all eighty two Mississippi Counties and the Choctaw Nation are dependent on Sixty Percent funding of the Emergency Management Performance Grant Program to fund Equipment, Salaries, Utilities, Communication Devices, and other necessities required to ensure public safety;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** The Lafayette County Board of Supervisor's hereby unanimously supports this resolution for the continued historical sixty percent of funding derived from the Emergency Management Performance Grant and supports the Mississippi Civil Defense Emergency Management Association's plea for funding of the Emergency Management Performance Grant Program Administered through the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency.
