


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE APPOINTMENT OF JURY COMMISSIONERS,


The vote on the motion was as follows:

ORDER APPOINTING JURY COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS THE REGULAR 1974 SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 378 OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF 1974 THAT A JURY SELECTION COMMISSION BE APPOINTED IN EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AND;

WHEREAS THE PROVISION OF SECTION 3 OF SAID ACT AND PARTICULARLY SECTION 13-5-6 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972 REQUIRE THE APPOINTMENTS BE MADE, ONE BY THE CIRCUIT JUDGE, ONE BY THE CHANCERY JUDGE AND ONE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EACH COUNTY IN THE PARTICULAR DISTRICT OF EACH JUDGE OR SENIOR JUDGE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THAT LINDA SALLIS, WHO IS DULY QUALIFIED AS AN ELECTOR AND RESIDENT CITIZEN IN SAID COUNTY AND NOT AN ATTORNEY NOR AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICIAL, THUS MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE LAW, BE AND IS HEREBY APPOINTED AS JURY COMMISSIONER OF SAID COUNTY FOR A TERM OF (4) YEARS BEGINNING AND BEING EFFECTIVE THE APRIL 2, 2018, AND HE SHALL ON OR BEFORE SAID DATE, OR BEFORE PERFORMING ANY OFFICIAL DUTIES AS JURY COMMISSIONER, TAKE THE GENERAL OATH OF OFFICE REQUIRED OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND FILE SAME WITH THE CHANCERY CLERK OF HIS COUNTY.

ORDER APPOINTING JURY COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS THE REGULAR 1974 SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 378 OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF 1974 THAT A JURY SELECTION COMMISSION BE APPOINTED IN EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AND;

WHEREAS THE PROVISION OF SECTION 3 OF SAID ACT AND PARTICULARLY SECTION 13-5-6 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972 REQUIRE THE APPOINTMENTS BE MADE, ONE BY THE CIRCUIT JUDGE, ON BY THE CHANCERY JUDGE AND ONE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EACH COUNTY IN THE PARTICULAR DISTRICT OF EACH JUDGE OR SENIOR JUDGE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE SENIOR CHANCELLOR OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THAT MAE FRANCES SHELBY, WHO IS DULY QUALIFIED AS AN ELECTOR AND RESIDENT CITIZEN IN SAID COUNTY AND NOT AN ATTORNEY NOR AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICIAL, THUS MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE LAW, BE AND IS HEREBY APPOINTED AS JURY COMMISSIONER OF SAID COUNTY FOR A TERM OF (4) YEARS BEGINNING AND BEING EFFECTIVE THE APRIL 2, 2018, AND HE SHALL ON OR BEFORE SAID DATE, OR BEFORE PERFORMING ANY OFFICIAL DUTIES AS JURY COMMISSIONER, TAKE THE GENERAL OATH OF OFFICE REQUIRED OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND FILE SAME WITH THE CHANCERY CLERK OF HIS COUNTY.
