RESOLUTION REQUESTING LOCAL STATE LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION TO INTRODUCE AND SEEK PASSAGE OF LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING CREATION OF THE LAFAYETTE COUNTY UTILITY AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors has determined, and hereby determines, that there is a need for additional and expanded public facilities and infrastructure, specifically broadband, natural gas, solid waste, storm water, public water and wastewater systems for economic development activities and the anticipated growth within Lafayette County.

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors in November 2017 adopted a new Comprehensive Plan to address the needed resources of the county with current and anticipated growth in the county and the concern of its citizens regarding the need for expansion of broadband, natural gas, storm water, and public water and wastewater capacity and quality of services throughout the county;

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors has also determined, and hereby determines, that the construction, acquisition, and/or operation of a user-funded solid waste, storm water, public water and wastewater systems is necessary to prevent and control the pollution of the Waters in this state;

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors further determined, and hereby determines, that creation of a county-wide utility authority through the cooperative effort by any area situated within Lafayette County, including the areas situated within the corporate boundaries of any existing municipality and other eligible municipalities, public agencies and political subdivisions, is necessary to address the growing population and concerns of residents of the county identified in the 2017 Compressive Plan in regard to providing adequate broadband, natural gas, solid waste, storm water, and public water and wastewater services to the citizens of Lafayette County; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors finds that local and private legislation permitting and authorizing the Board of Supervisors of Lafayette County, Mississippi to create the Lafayette County Utility Authority for the purpose of developing, constructing, acquiring, operating and managing broadband, natural gas, solid waste, water and wastewater systems within Lafayette County and of serving the interests and general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Lafayette County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. That the local state legislative delegation immediately introduce and seek the passage of legislation, in substantially the same form as Attachment "A" hereto, authorizing the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors to create the Lafayette County Utility Authority.
