


**ORDER: APPROVE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE

Memorandum of Understanding

It is agreed to that the Northern Region A team, representing the Mississippi Department of Health and other agencies involved in disaster response have identified The Lafayette County Arena 70 CR 406, Oxford, MS as a Lafayette

County site where the Strategic National Stock Pile would be deployed in the event of an act of bioterrorism. Access to the site shall be limited to those persons authorized to assist in the provision of Stockpile medications or vaccines and those recommended to receive the medications or vaccines. Any other additions, deletions, or termination of this agreement shall be done in writing by mutual agreement.
