


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE LOCAL AND PRIVATE LEGISLATION

*Example***House Bill 1576**

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE ANNUALLY TO THE INTERFAITH COMPASSION MINISTRIES HOMELESS SHELTER PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Supervisors of Lafayette County, Mississippi, in its discretion, may contribute an amount not to exceed ~~Three Thousand~~ *\$20,000* ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00)~~ annually from any available funds of the county, to the Interfaith Compassion Ministries Homeless Shelter programs and facilities.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after October 1, 2011.

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING LOCAL STATE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY TO DONATE TO

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County, Mississippi Board of Supervisors wishes to donate to Interfaith Compassion Ministries up to \$30,000 per year for four years.


