**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional entities of the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors, Mississippi; the City of Oxford, Mississippi; and the University of Mississippi fully appreciate the importance of joint coordination and communication for common objectives that affect the entirety of the Lafayette-Oxford-University ("LOU") Community, and

**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional entities of the LOU Community value the important and vital nature of planning to meet goals of their thriving and growing community, and

**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional entities of the LOU Community have each developed comprehensive master plans for their respective jurisdictional areas that have identified transportation needs and improvements to varying degrees, among other key planning components, and

**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional entities of the LOU Community determined the need for a joint plan to more specifically identify and implement transportation needs and improvements of the community that interconnect through, around, and across jurisdictional boundaries, and


**WHEREAS**, the jurisdictional entities of the LOU Community jointly participated in the LOU Transportation Plan development that identified short, mid and long term transportation needs and improvements of the community through a joint and open process involving the LOU Technical Committee, the LOU Advisory Committee and by conducting two open forum meetings to obtain public comment on the plan and the proposed transportation needs and improvements, and


