ORDER: REQUEST THAT CITIZENS NOT GATHER IN GROUPS OF MORE THAN FIFTY PEOPLE, USE ONLINE RESOURCES, MAIL, DRIVE THROUGH WINDOW AND PHONE CALLS AS OPTIONS TO FINDING SOLUTIONS TO THEIR INQUIRES INSTEAD OF PERSONALLY VISITING COUNTY OFFICES AND FOLLOW CDC RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING AND SAFEGUARDING SELF AND FAMILY FROM COVID 19
