**RESOLUTION REQUESTING GOVERNOR TO PROCLAIM
A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2021, the Board of Supervisors
of **Lafayette County** found that due to the impact (or imminent threat)
of Winter Weather Storm a condition of extreme peril (earthquake, flood, hazmat, hurricane, severe
storm, winter storm, other)
to life and property did exist in **Lafayette County**; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2021, in accordance with State Law 33-15-17(d) the
Board of Supervisors declared that an emergency does exist throughout said county; and

WHEREAS, it has now been found that local resources are unable to cope with the
effects of said emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED AND ORDERED that a copy of
this declaration be forwarded to the Governor of Mississippi with the request that he proclaim
the **County of Lafayette** to be in a State of Emergency; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that **Steve Quarles, Emergency Management Coordinator**,
is thereby designated as the authorized representative of the **County of Lafayette**
for the purpose of receipt, processing, and coordination of all inquiries
and requirements necessary to obtain available State and Federal assistance.

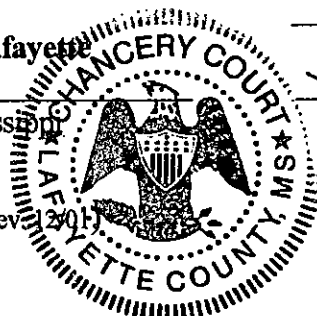
