Reviewing the bid documents submitted by the contractors, there was a total of five (5) bids. Three of the five submitted utilizing the proper bid form, acknowledged the addendums and submitted a bid bond. However, the lowest bidder (Chickasaw Solutions) did not submit their bid using the proper bid form, did not submit a bid bond, or acknowledge the addendums issued, and did not provide a time line of completion of the project. The second lowest bidder (Lee Mechanical Solutions, Inc.) did use the proper forms, provided a bid bond, acknowledged the addendums and provide a time line of 90 calendar days to complete the project.

Because Chickasaw Solutions did not submit their bid in the proper format and did not provide a bid bond, I recommend that Chickasaw Solutions be disqualified as a bidder. Therefore, it is my recommendation that Lee Mechanical Solution, Inc. be awarded the contract for this project at amount of ninety-six thousand three hundred dollars (\$96,300.00).
