## RESOLUTION OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE NECESSITY FOR ISSUANCE OF STATE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

WHEREAS, Lafayette County has undertaken a project as defined in Section 54 of Senate Bill 2971, 2021 Regular Legislative Session, to assist the Lafayette County, Mississippi, in paying the costs associated with the extension of West Oxford Loop in Lafayette County (hereinafter "the Project"), with an anticipated completion date of <u>December</u> 2024; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY LAFAYETTE COUNTY that, pursuant Section 54 of Senate Bill 2971, 2021 Regular Legislative Session, the Department of Finance and Administration will adopt a resolution to be presented to the State Bond Commission declaring the necessity for the issuance of \$2,000,000.00 in General Obligation Bonds to assist Lafayette County with the Project for the purpose as stated in paragraph one; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board President of Lafayette County is hereby authorized to represent Lafayette County in all dealings with the Department of Finance and Administration and/or the State Bond Commission and to assist in the issuance of said bonds in any manner that is required.
