ORDER: AUTHORIZE A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION, BELLE TERRE, IN A RURAL (A-1) DISTRICT ON LAFAYETTE COUNTY PARCEL 123-08-006 CONTINGENT UPON THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS BEING MET
