


ORDER: APPROVE COUNTY ENGINEER TO APPLY FOR ERBR FUNDING


Motion was made by David Rikard, duly seconded by Larry Gillespie, to approve County Engineer to apply for ERBR Funding.

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) is soliciting projects for the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund (ERBRF) Program for emergency repairs to public roads and bridges in the state, and

WHEREAS, *the LAFAYETTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS* desires to submit an application for multiple bridge replacement projects for NBI Bridge Structure Numbers:

SA3600000000018, SA3600000000019, SA3600000000101, SA3600000000134,
SA3600000000138, SA3600000000144, SA3600000000161 and also Road
Improvements for Intersection Sight Distance Improvements at the Intersection of MS
Highway 6 (US 278) and CR 217 and

WHEREAS, the *LAFAYETTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS* acknowledges that if the project is awarded, grant funding will not exceed the amount requested in the application or the low bid, whichever is less, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that *LAFAYETTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS* authorizes *LARRY L. BRITT, COUNTY ENGINEER* to prepare and submit applications for the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund Program and authorizes the President of the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors to execute such grants and/or related documents required for commencement of the project and any future agreements or grant related documents such as a project MOA.

This is the suggested priority list of bridges to submit for the 2022 ERBR Program. This list is pretty much the same as last year. I am not sure if you all want me to move CR 217/Hwy 6 Intersection up or not. I think the top three have to stay like they are to get paving projects approved.

I will have to have this Board Order on Monday, May 2, 2022 because the deadline to submit this year has been moved up to May 8, 2022. They only gave us a week to submit the application this time.
