


**ORDER: SPREAD ON THE MINUTES RECAPITULATION OF REAL AND

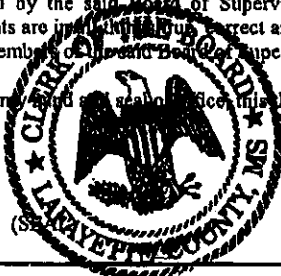
