ORDER: AUTHORIZE KTW PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT'S CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO DEVELOP A SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION IN A RURAL (A-1) DISTRICT ON LAFAYETTE COUNTY PARCEL 171-12-015 WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS: (1) NO MORE THAN EIGHT LOTS SHALL BE PERMITTED (2) THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION PLAT MUST INDICATE ADEQUATE EXISTING VEGETATIVE SCREENING, AND/OR DEFAULT ZONING DISTRICT SCREENING OR ACCEPTABLE VEGETATIVE SCREENING IN LIEU OF DEFAULT SCREENING
