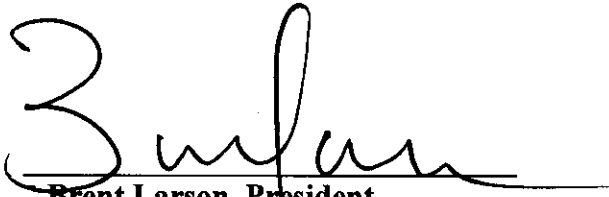
**ORDER: ENTER EXECUTIVE SESSION TO DISCUSS POTENTIAL LITIGATION
AND CONTRACT NEGOTIATION**

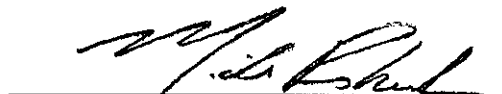
Motion was made by John Morgan, duly seconded by Tim Gordon, to enter Executive Session to discuss potential litigation and contract negotiation.
