


**ORDER: SPREAD ON THE MINUTES ORDER SETTING COURT REPORTER

LAFAYETTE COUNTY PAYS 25%**



**ORDER SETTING SALARY FOR COURT REPORTER  
FOR THE THIRD CIRCUIT COURT DISTRICT**

There having come on for consideration the matter of the increase of the salary for Dana Rakestraw, Kathy Bruce, Regina Russell, and Tiffany Seawright, Court Reporters. It is hereby Ordered by the undersigned Kelly Luther, Senior Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit Court District that, pursuant to Section 9-13-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated that the salary of said, Dana Rakestraw, Kathy Bruce, Regina Russell, and Tiffany Seawright hereby set at \$76,800.00 per year, plus benefits, effective July 1, 2025, to be paid and prorated among the counties in the District pursuant to *Miss. Code Ann. § 9-13-19 (Supp. 2018)*. Said salary shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.

The Court further finds that such salary and benefits shall be prorated between the counties of the district according to Mississippi Code 9-13-19 (1), as follows:

<b>COUNTY</b>	<b>PERCENTAGE OF SALARY</b>
<b>Chickasaw County</b>	<b>11%</b>
<b>Lafayette County</b>	<b>25%</b>
<b>Marshall County</b>	<b>25%</b>
<b>Union County</b>	<b>15%</b>
<b>Benton County</b>	<b>4%</b>
<b>Calhoun County</b>	<b>9%</b>
<b>Tippah County</b>	<b>11%</b>
