



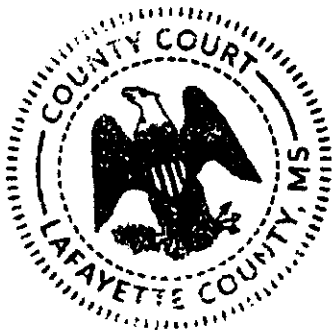

ORDER

UPON EXAMINATION, the Court finds that the salary for services rendered by the full-time court reporters pursuant to Section 9-13-19 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, has increased for court reporters with Ten (10) years or greater service to Seventy-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$76,800) per year beginning July 1, 2025. Accordingly, the Court hereby ORDERS:

1. That the salary of the Court Reporter of Lafayette County Court be increased to Seventy-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$76,800) per year beginning July 1, 2025, with benefits.
