Motion was made by Scott Allen, duly seconded by Tim Gordon, to approve the Cedar Bucket Final Site Plan.



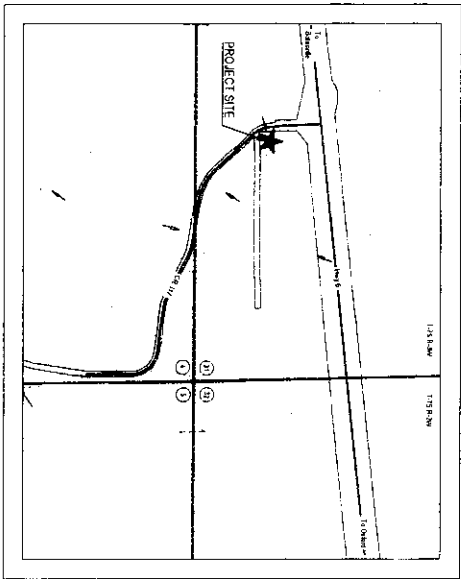

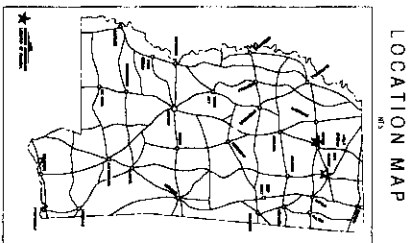
CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR: Cedar Bucket Building Addition Hwy 6 West Lafayette County, Mississippi

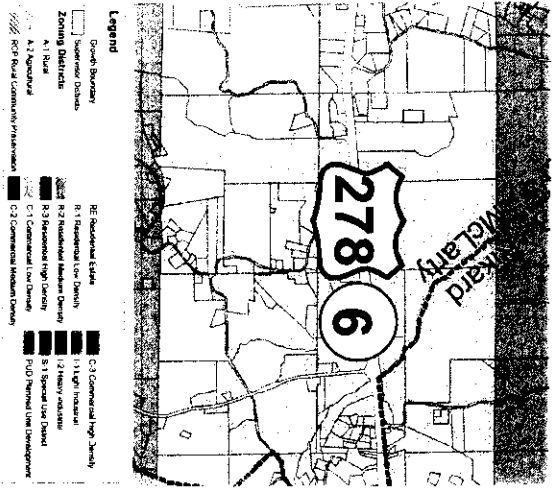

The Planning Commission recommends approval of the DORM Store, LLC conditional use permit request to develop a Light Industrial (~~L-2~~) use in an Rural (A-1) District on Lafayette County parcels 157-25-016 and 157-25-016.04 (Planning Commission Case 25-415).
