


HEREBY ORDERED, that pursuant to M.C.A., Sections 33-15-17 & 31, the County Tax Assessor/Collector is authorized and directed to suspend the practice of not issuing car tags to County residents that have delinquent and unpaid solid waste accounts or liens resulting therefrom, as required by M.C.A., Section 19-5-22, effective immediately and until October 1, 2020.
