Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all members of the

Lafayette County Fire Department are adequately compensated for

advanced medical training.

Scope: This policy shall apply to all members of the department that are

certified to the Nationally Registered Advanced Emergency Medical

Technician (AEMT) or Nationally Registered Paramedic level.

Paramedic

Fulltime: \$8,000 per year

Parttime: \$3.84 per hour (\$4,000/1040hrs) Total per hour \$16.35

Paid per Call: \$16.35 per call

AEMT

Fulltime: \$4,000 per year

Parttime: \$1.93 per hour (\$2,000/1040hrs) Total per hour \$14.43

Paid per Call: \$14.43 per call

In order to receive payment for advanced medical training, members must maintain a current National Registry of EMT's Certification, State of Mississippi EMS License, Basic Life Support Certification, Advanced Cardiac Life Support Certification, and Pediatric Advanced Life Support Certification.
