The Board next considered the conditional use permit request submitted by Stonewater Adolescent Recovery Center which was before the Board upon the recommendation of the Lafayette County Planning Commission. After considering the record, including the supplemental statements of the interested parties and the arguments of counsel which addressed concerns related to the compatibility of the proposed expansion with the adjacent residential uses and the incidents of runaways from the Center presented during the April 18, 2022 public hearing and upon further argument presented on this day, the following motion was made:

MOTION: GRANT CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO EXPAND A COMMERCIAL LOW DENSITY (C-1) USE, STONEWATER ADOLESCENT ADDICTION RECOVERY CENTER, IN A RURAL (A-1) DISTRICT ON LAFAYETTE COUNTY PARCEL 149-31-005

Motion was made by Chad McLarty, duly seconded by David Rikard, to grant a Conditional Use Permit to expand a Commercial Low Density (C-1) use, Stonewater Adolescent Addiction Recovery Center, in a Rural (A-1) District on Lafayette County Parcel 149-31-005.
