In accordance with the site plan and supporting documents submitted to the Lafayette County Planning Department on April 18, 2022, the Planning Commission recommends approval of the Lafayette County Law Enforcement Association conditional use permit request to expand a quasi-facility, The Buddy East Law Enforcement Training Facility shooting range expansion of a quasi-public facility in an Agricultural (A-2) District on Lafayette County parcel 176-23-005.01 (Planning Commission Case 22-306).
