The Planning Commission recommends approval of the International Guest House conditional use permit request to expand a quasi-public facility in a Rural (A-1) District on Lafayette County parcel 181-02-026 (Planning Commission Case 22-107). In addition to the requirements of Section 2105 of the Lafayette County Zoning Ordinance, the Planning Commission recommends the following:

- 1. Accept existing vegetative screening in lieu of standard requirements.
- 2. Grant a variance from requirements of Article V Section 4, F for distance from a fire hydrant. (Required to install a dry hydrant)
- 3. The International Guest House must maintain adequate livestock fencing.
