


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE RECAPITULATION OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

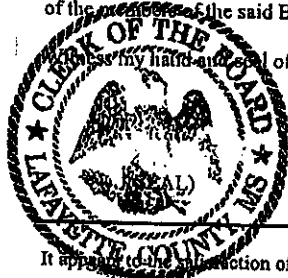
