


**ORDER: OPEN PUBLIC HEARING ON WHETHER OR NOT A CONDITIONAL USE
PERMIT IS NEEDED TO EXPAND AN EXISTING QUASI-PUBLIC FACILITY,
GREAT RIVER UTILITY WELL AND WATER TREATMENT FACILITY, IN A
RESIDENTIAL LOW DENSITY (R-1) DISTRICT ON LAFAYETTE COUNTY
