


**ORDER: AUTHORIZE APPOINTMENT OF SIX ADDITIONAL POLL WORKERS

Motion was made by David Rikard, duly seconded by Brent Larson, to authorize appointment of six additional poll workers for elections.


The vote on the motion was as follows:

§ 23-15-235. Appointment of additional poll managers.

In addition to the poll managers appointed pursuant to Section 23-15-231, for the first five hundred (500) registered voters in each voting precinct, the election commissioners may, in their discretion, appoint not more than three (3) persons to serve as poll managers of the election. The election commissioners may, in their discretion, appoint additional persons to serve as poll managers for each one thousand (1,000) registered voters or fraction thereof in each voting precinct above the first five hundred (500), as determined necessary by the election commissioners and approved by the board of supervisors. Any person appointed as poll manager shall be a qualified elector of the county in which the voting precinct is located.

The Election Commission may, in its discretion, appoint additional poll managers based upon the number of registered voters in each precinct.

Registered Voters in a Precinct	Minimum Number of Poll Managers	Number of Additional Poll Managers	Maximum Number of Poll Managers
0-500	3	3	6
501 or more	3	6	As many as determined by ECs and approved by Board
