


**ORDER: APPROVE COMMUNITY CHURCH CONSTRUCTING LITTLE FREE

Motion was made by John Morgan, duly seconded by Greg Bynum, to approve Community Church constructing little free pantry boxes at five Lafayette County Fire Departments.


The vote on the motion was as follows:


In an effort to give Lafayette County another resource to food, Community Church is asking for permission to place Little Free Pantry boxes at the following Lafayette County Fire Stations:
